Order Received

An order has been received from a major Japanese company for the first stage of a new Wellington "Total Integration" development project. On completion, the new project will deliver a Wellington-based version of a common appliance component that is used world wide; several tens of millions of units are sold annually in this product category.

The ordering company is a respected household name in most countries, and stands amongst the industry leaders technically. The Wellington development is intended, amongst other improvements, to reduce the component's electricity consumption – thereby cutting the running costs of the household appliances that use this component - and its production costs. The ordering company expects electricity-saving designs to begin to dominate its product line over the next few years, and the intention is to begin volume production of this component during 2008.

This particular project offers the largest potential volume of any yet addressed by Wellington and is an application of the company's newly-developed "Monsoon" motor, electronics and software technology. Wellington's Monsoon system offers improved production costs compared to other known electricity saving motors. Several similar projects are in discussion with other companies.
